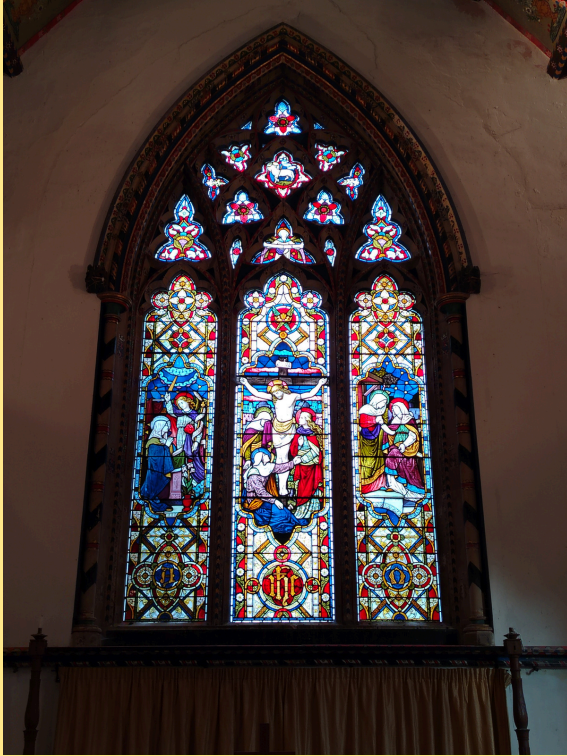
A CHURCH HUNT

STAINED GLASS WINDOWS



Did you know?

- Stained glass windows tell stories from the bible.
- The bright colours and small details help to show us religious history.
- The colours used symbolise (show) different things. Blue is heaven, red shows Christ sacrifice, green is for hope and growth, and purple represents royalty and penitence.
- The light coming through stained glass windows – links to the light of God and faith.

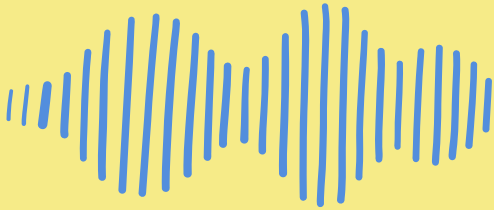

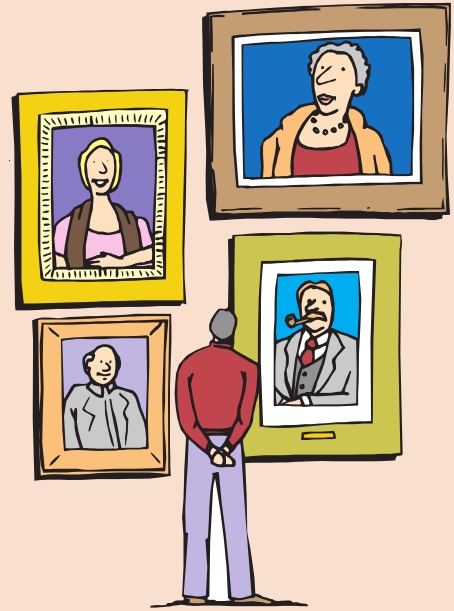

- The figures on the Nave roof are the 12 apostles and 2 female Saints.

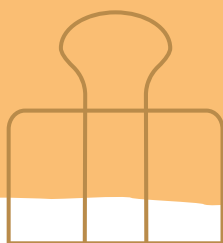
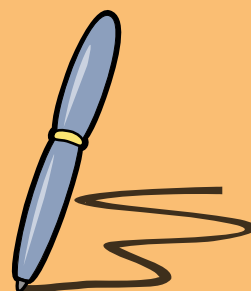




WRITE A PRAYER!



Prayer is a way that we talk to God. We can talk to God in lots of different ways, and that includes writing a letter or note.

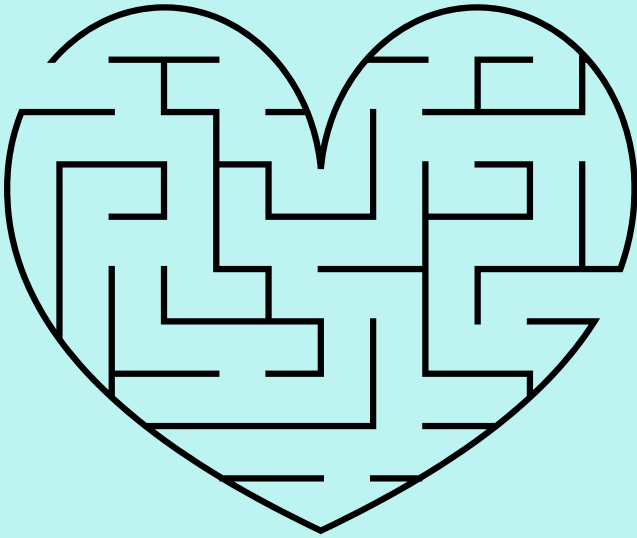
